



APSA Hybrid Rice Production Training Course

Overview

Putting emphasis on strengthening hybrid rice production in the region, APSA, in collaboration with the International Research Institute (IRRI) and Jiangxi Academy of Agricultural Science, is giving a month-long training opportunity for APSA members to acquire practical knowledge in this field.

The 30-day course, which will be held from 1 June–30 June 2007, includes hands-on technical trainings in laboratory and field production. Participants will be able to get access to sources of parental line involving CMS and TGMS technology and establish a working hybrid rice network in the region.

To be conducted in Nanchang City of Jiangxi Province, the course will also open opportunities for participants to learn more from China's successful experience in hybrid rice production and commercialization.

Course Fee: US\$2,500

The fee already covers the following expenses

- Tuition
- Accommodation for the duration of the course (Board & Lodging)
- Meals for the entire month
- Course materials
- Field Trips
- Local transportation
- Medical Insurance

Participants will shoulder their plane fare to and from Jiangxi Province and the cost of their visa. Supporting documents for visa requirements for travel to China shall be provided.
